Exercise with your dog before you leave: You should play or exercise with your dog before heading off to school. A tired dog is less likely to experience stress when you leave.

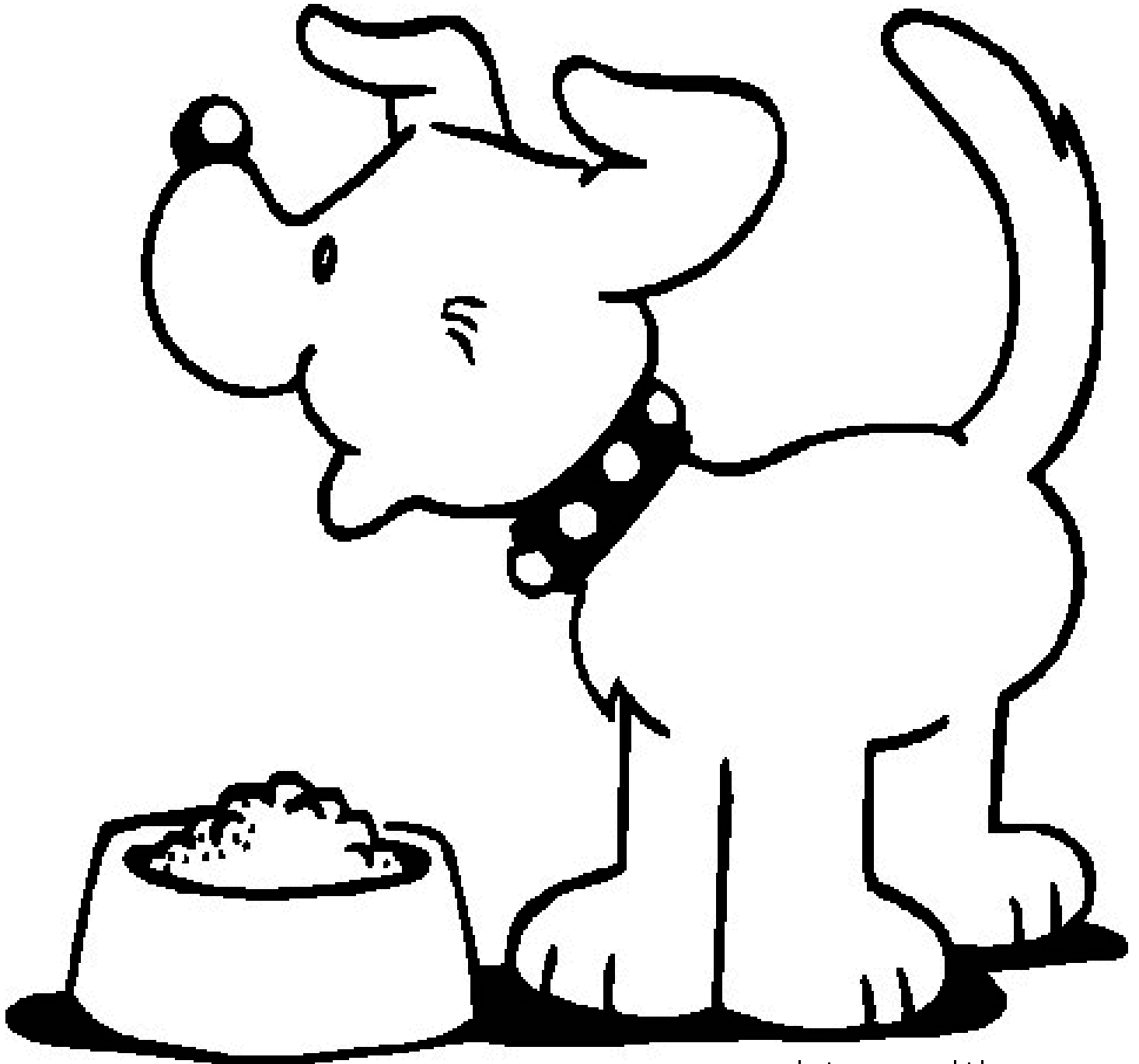


Promote independence: Don't make a big deal about leaving, and only leave him alone for short periods of time at first. When you come home, simply greet him and return to your routine.
