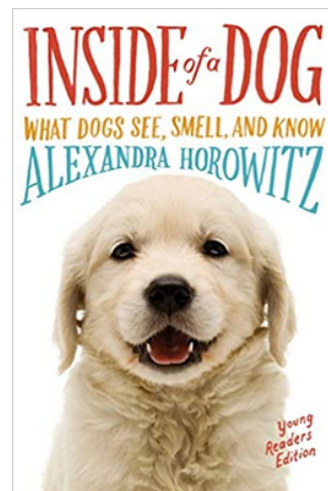

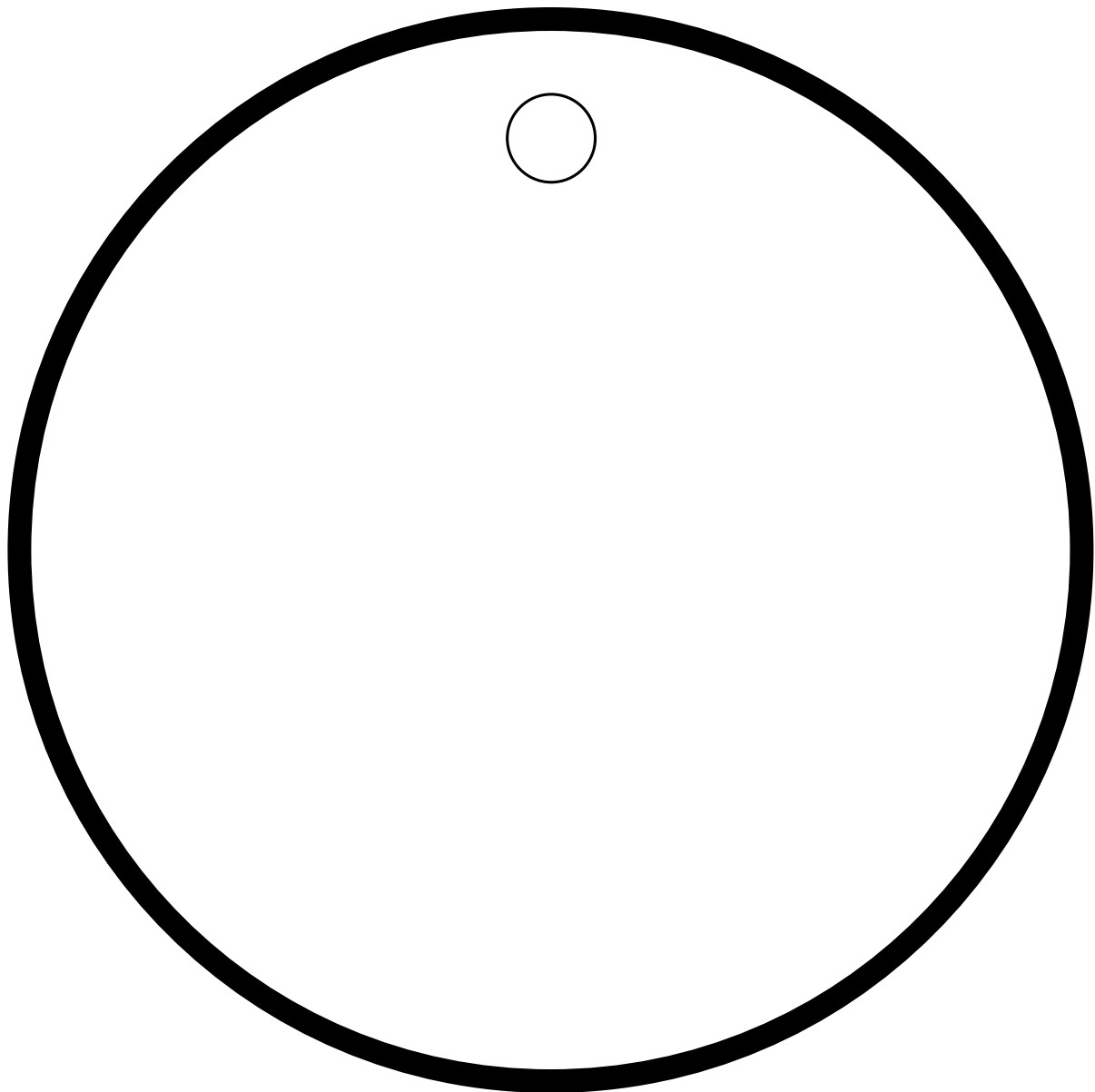

April 30th is International Search and Rescue (SAR) Dog Day!

What is a SAR dog?



A SAR dog uses their incredible sense of smell to find missing humans, and even missing pets!

How does it work?



Dogs and humans use something called sensory receptor sites to process smell. Humans have approximately 6 million of these receptors while dogs have 100 million or more! Additionally, the part of their brain that processes scent is 40 times larger than a human's! This allows them to track scents humans can't pick up.

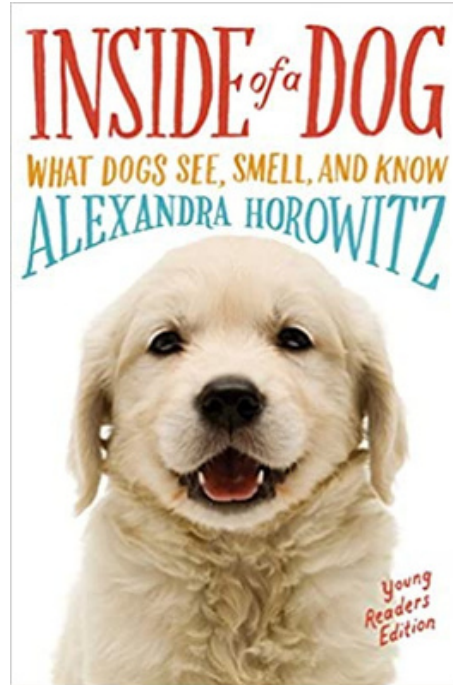

Our Book of the Month!

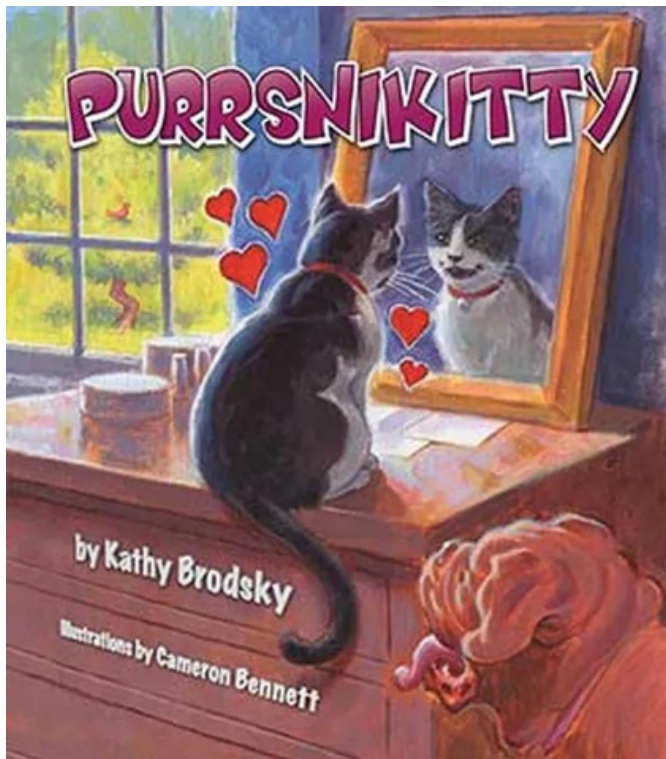
