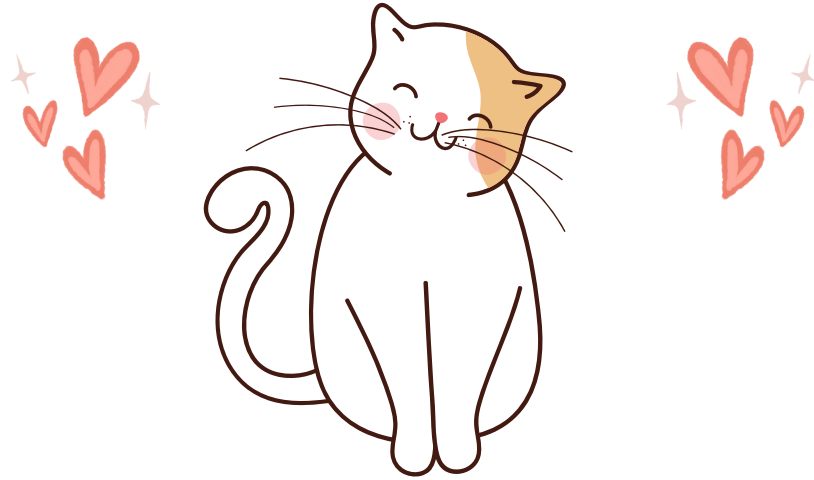

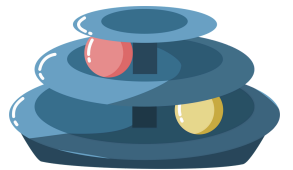
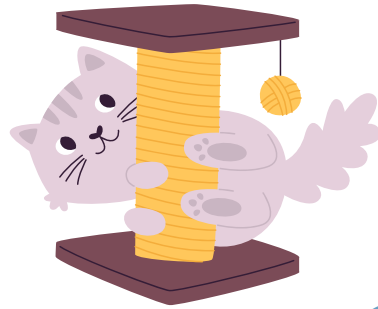

Rabbit Enrichment Ideas!



Rabbits are curious, playful, and smart animals that really benefit from daily enrichment. Below are some ideas of things you can provide at home to keep your bunny busy. There are things we offer to many of our own shelter bunnies!

- Tunnels – cat tunnels are great for rabbits.
- Cardboard boxes – rabbits like it when they have 2 doorways cut out for easy entry and exit.
- Toilet rolls, tissue boxes, or egg cartons filled with hay, shredded paper, or yummy treats are inexpensive toy ideas.
- Forage trays – boxes or plastic trays filled with shredded paper with scattered treats mixed through for foraging.
- String or twine tied across like a washing line with green leafy vegetables pegged to it for your bunny to pull down and eat.
- Dehydrating fruit and vegetables to make tasty snacks.
- Plastic cat balls with bells inside for pushing and throwing around.
- Plastic baby toys that rattle for throwing.
- Plastic or wooden bird toys that can be clipped to the bars of the cage.
- Fruit tree branches (i.e., apple, pear) and leaves are great for munching on!

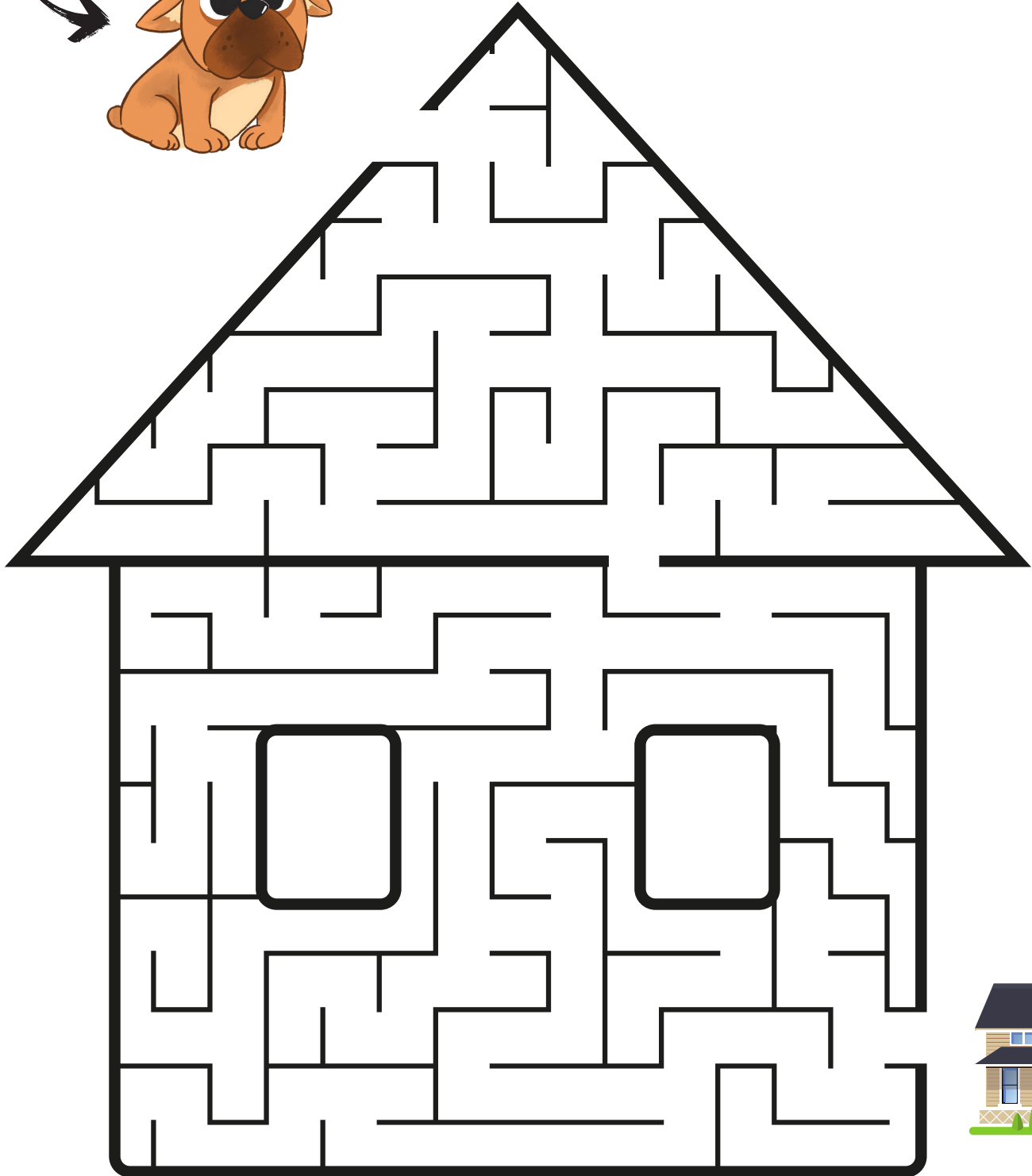

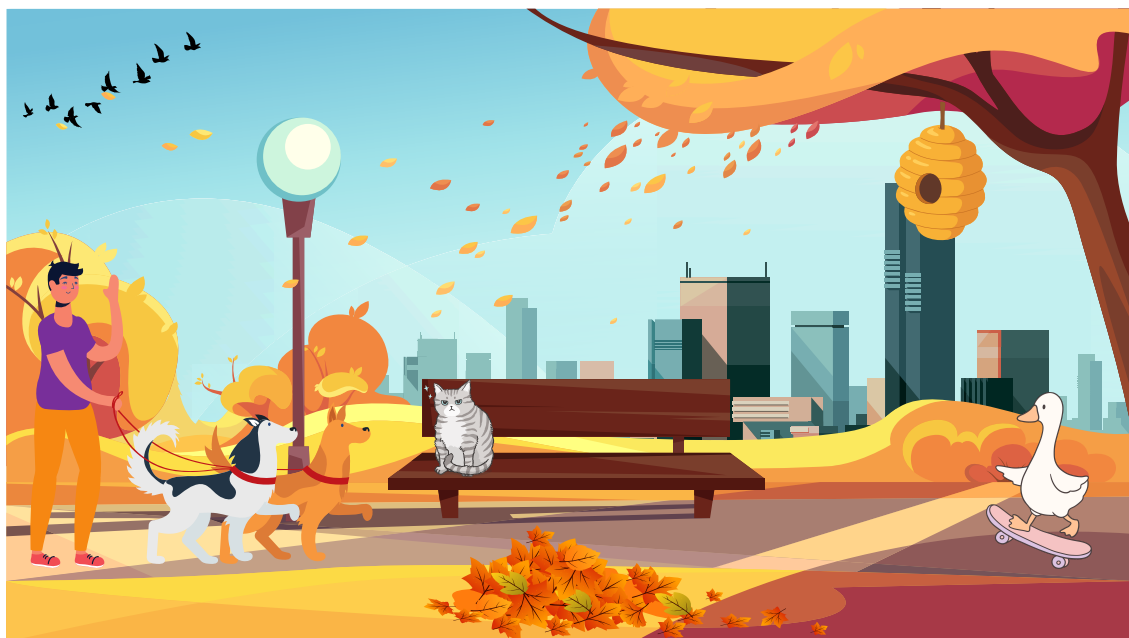

Circle the differences between the two pictures.



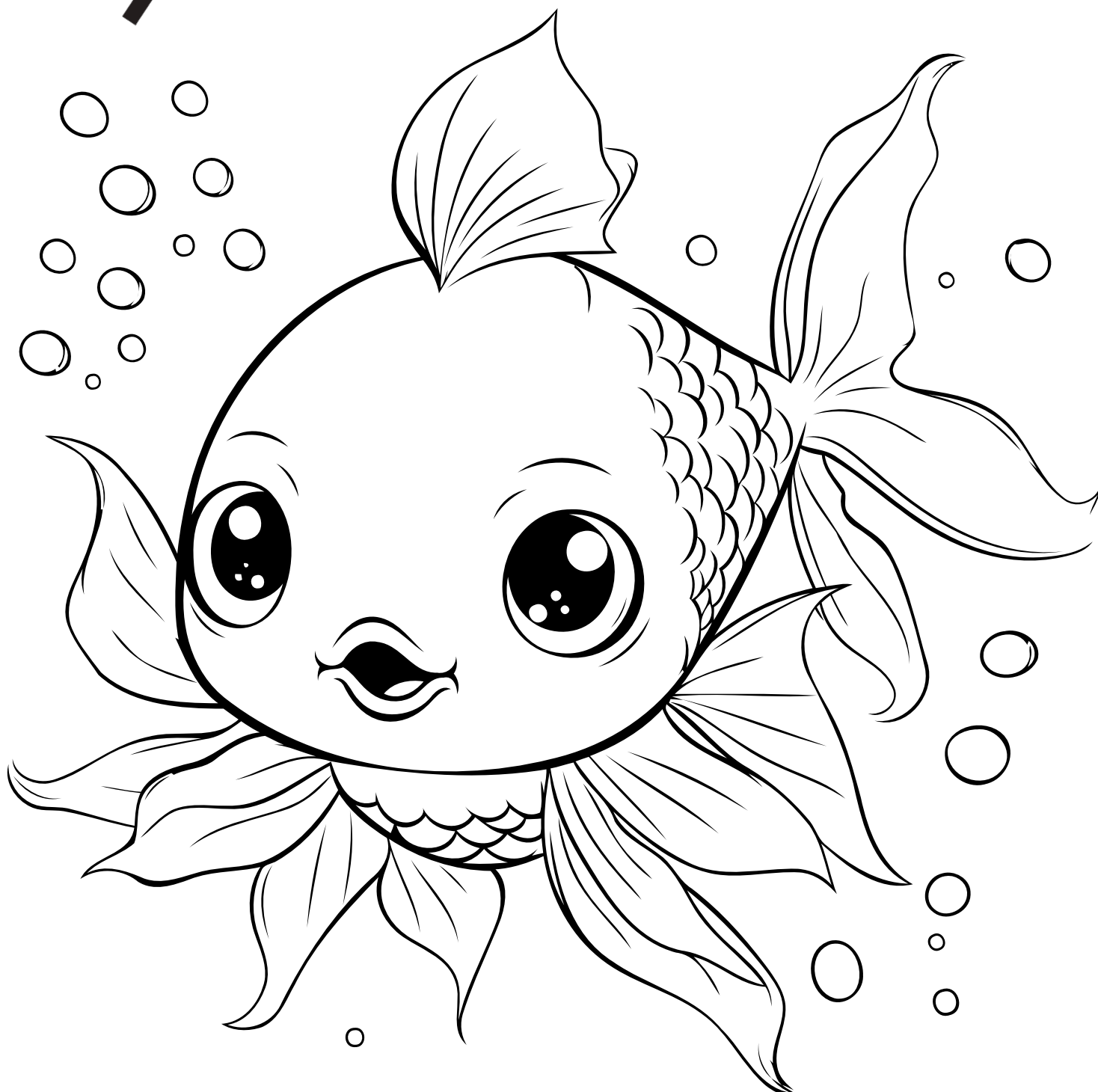

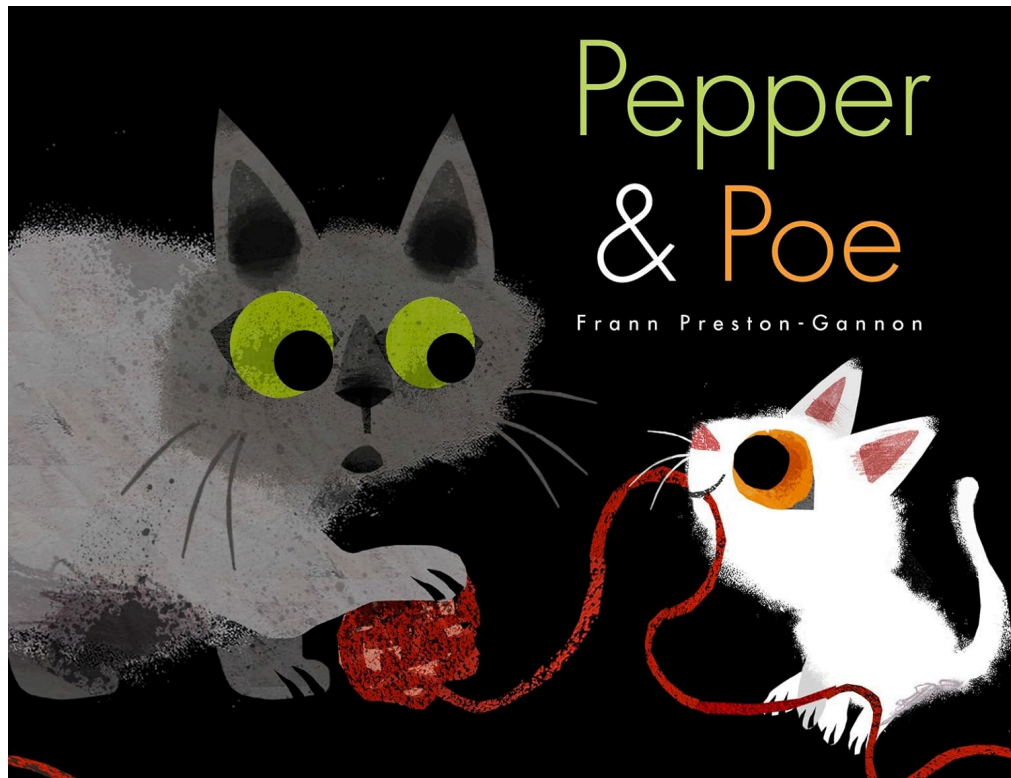
